To be eligible for nomination, you must comply with all the requirements including those in the checklist below. Please refer to the Steering Committee meetings, member roles and responsibilities and the Election Criteria, this is in addition to the [WSSCC Governance Document](#). Nominations will be reviewed by the Elections sub-committee. This will be followed by a confidential electronic voting process.

**Please note the following:**

- A member can nominate him/herself or be nominated by another member from any region but **only** members from that region may vote for that nominee.
- The Nominee must have been a member for a minimum of 2 years.

2	Countersigned by 4 WSSCC members from at least 2 countries with no more than two members from any one country and who are not close relatives who have received Tables 1 & 2 (page 2)	
3	A short biography (maximum 1 page)	
4	A brief manifesto giving details of (approximately 1 page):  a) why the Nominee would be a suitable Steering Committee member b) what the Nominee can contribute to the Steering Committee and c) what the Nominee has accomplished in sanitation and public health in the past 5 years.	
6	I can attend the WSSCC Steering Committee meeting in <b>Geneva on 10-12 April 2018</b> .
