- ENSURE ACCESS TO IMPROVED SANITATION AND HYGIENE SERVICES
- HIGHLIGHT THE RIGHTS OF GIRLS AND WOMEN, AND PEOPLE IN VULNERABLE SITUATIONS
- DRAW SPECIAL ATTENTION TO THE 'LIFE COURSE' APPROACH, INCLUDING MENSTRUAL HEALTH AND HYGIENE



NATIONAL COORDINATOR MODALITY

REINFORCE WSSCC'S COUNTRY CONVENING ROLE BY ENSURING CLOSER ALIGNMENT WITH OTHER ENABLING ENVIRONMENT, POLICY INITIATIVES, PLATFORMS AND MECHANISMS

CAPITALIZE ON EXISTING AND NEW COUNTRY ENGAGEMENT PLANS, INCLUDING THE INTERFACE BETWEEN NATIONAL AND SUBNATIONAL AGENCIES, AND VOICE OF CIVIL SOCIETY
